

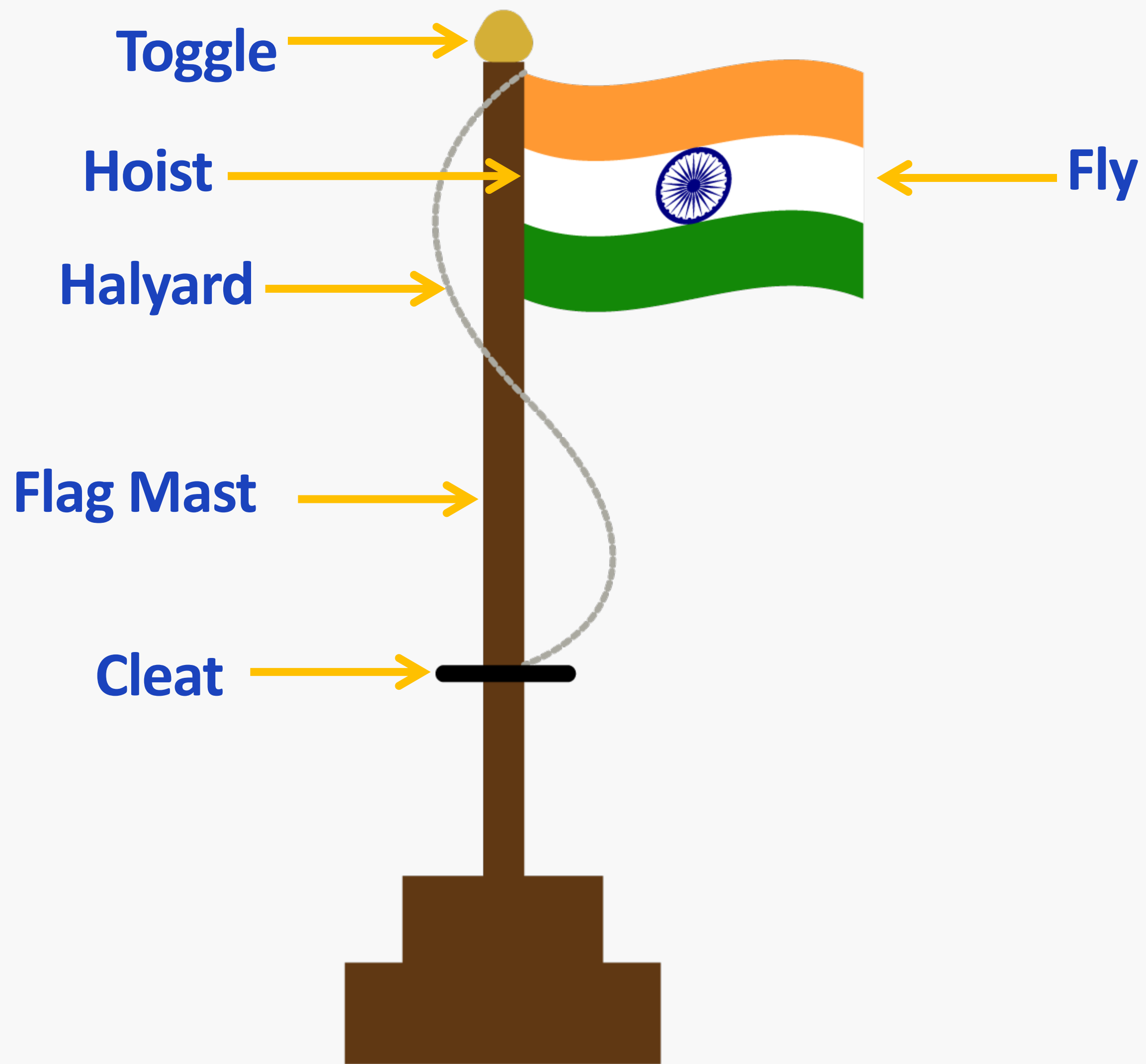

Parts of a Flag Pole



- Flag Mast** – Pole used to unfurl the Flag
- Halyard** – Rope used to Hoist or Lower the Flag
- Toggle** – Piece of Wood attached to Top End of Rope
- Hoist** – Portion of Flag Near the Flag Pole
- Fly** – Portion of Flag Away from the Flag Pole
- Cleat** – Piece of Wood/Metal to which Halyard is tied

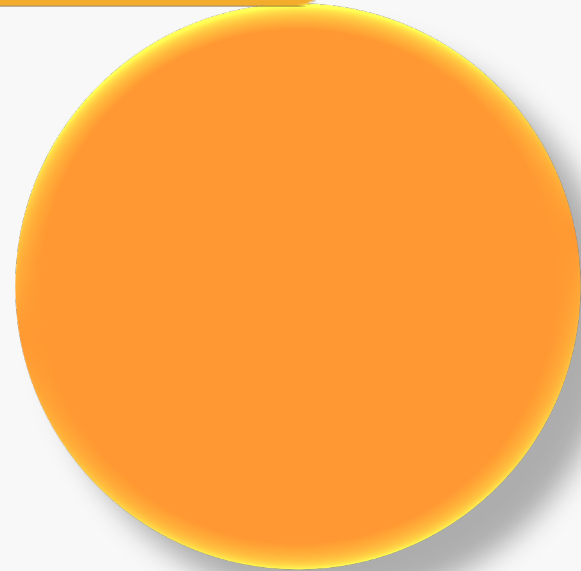
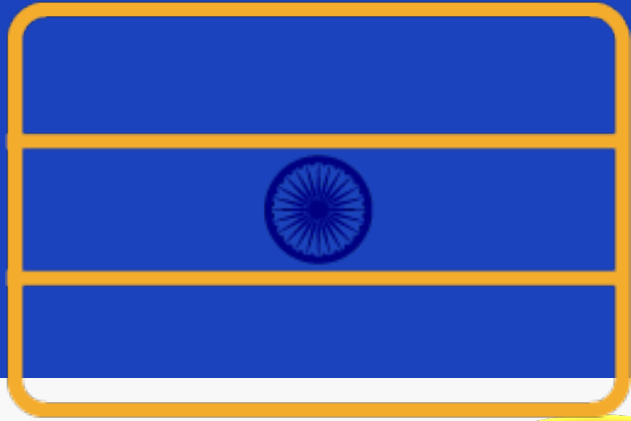

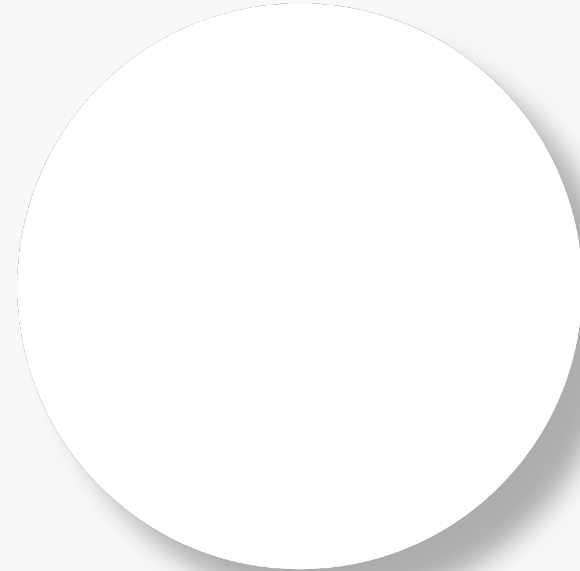

Evolution of National Flag began in 1905. The present one was adopted on July 22nd 1947

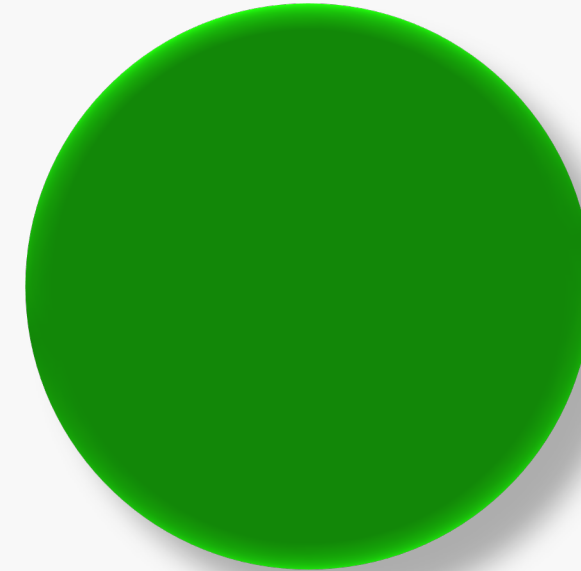

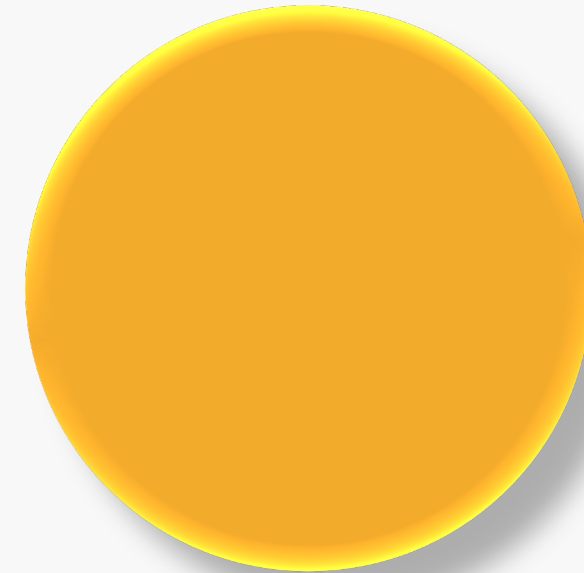

Full- & Half- Masting



Flag at Full Mast : Breaking the flag is done by drawing the folded flag at top of the mast and flying the flag with a quick jerk

Flag at Half Mast : First raise the flag at top of the mast , then lower it to half mast (the upper end of flag at half mast should be at lower end of flag at full mast).

Only the **Indian National flag** is flown half-mast; All other flags remain at normal height. This is done in the event of the death of a dignitary (**National Mourning**)

NOTE:



- The **World Scout Flag** can be used on Appropriate Occasion and when used, it shall fly at a lower level than **National Flag**, at its left and higher level than **Bharat Scouts & Guides Flag** at its right.
- When **National Flag** and **Bharat Scouts and Guides Flag** is flown simultaneously, **The Bharat Scouts and Guides flag** shall fly at a lower level than **National Flag**, at its left
- Flag is hoisted from Sunrise to Sunset.
- Flag should never touch the ground
