The Scout Law

There is only ONE Law divided into 9 parts.

1. A Scout is Trustworthy.
2. A Scout is Loyal.
3. A Scout is Friend to all and a Brother to every other Scout.
4. A Scout is Courteous.
5. A Scout is Friend to Animals and Loves Nature.
6. A Scout is Disciplined and Helps to Protect Public Property.
7. A Scout is Courageous.
8. A Scout is Thrifty.
9. A Scout is Pure in Thought, Word and Deed.

1. A Scout is Trustworthy

You are expected to tell the truth always and not only when it is convenient. You carry out orders even when no one is watching. Your word must mean something, and must be reliable.

2. A Scout is Loyal

Loyalty without being fanatic must be your ideals. It also means being fair and avoiding cutting corners is achieving your goals. Your participation in Community Development Projects is a measure of your Loyalty.

3. A Scout is Friend to all and a Brother to every other Scout

This bond of brotherhood is what makes Scouting such a close knit movement. Friendliness, Openness, and a ready smile must differentiate you as a Scout from other boys.

4. A Scout is Courteous

You should be courteous (polite) to everyone, low or high, small or big, because you believe in the dignity of man. Courtesy comes from the position of strength and not of weakness. You must be polite especially to women, children and elderly people. Do not accept any reward for being polite and courteous and never forget to thank for the favors received.

5. A Scout is Friend to Animals and Loves Nature

You do not let them suffer unnecessarily. It must be your endeavor to protect life. You should with the help of others try and save the environment and keep the ecological balance.

6. A Scout is Disciplined and Helps to Protect Public Property

To achieve any goal you need discipline and if you do not learn it now when you are young, it is going to be difficult to achieve afterwards. Punctuality, smartness and orderliness are part of this law.

7. A Scout is Courageous

The true meaning of this is not to have any fear, but rather overcome them and face the danger when it is necessary, especially for helping others. Scouts are known for their 'Never say Die' Spirit.

Do not get carried away with advertisements and spend your time and money on things which are not required. Avoid wastage of natural resources and take and use only what is required.
